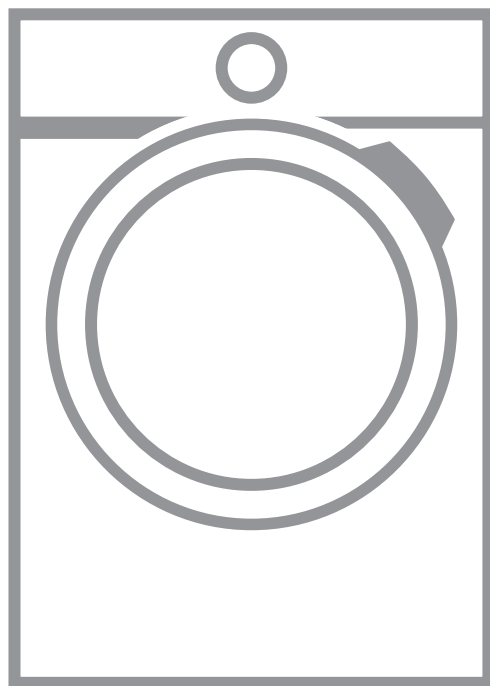

## 1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Before installing and operating the device, carefully read the attached manual. The manufacturer is not responsible for any injury or damage resulting from improper installation or operation. Always keep this manual handy in a safe place for future reference.

### 1.1 Safety of children and persons with disabilities



**ATTENTION!**

There is a risk of suffocation, injury or permanent disability.

- This appliance can be used by children over 8 years of age and persons with reduced mobility. physical, sensory or mental capabilities and lack of experience or knowledge unless under the supervision of a person responsible for their safety or after receiving

appropriate instructions to enable them to operate the appliance safely and to understand the hazards involved in its use.

- Do not allow children to play with the device.
- Children under 3 years of age are strictly prohibited from being near the device while it is operating.
- Keep all packaging materials out of the reach of children and dispose of materials properly.
- Keep detergents out of the reach of children.
- Keep children and pets away from the appliance when the door is open.



- If the appliance is equipped with a child safety lock, it must be switched on.
- Cleaning and user maintenance of the device should not be performed by children without supervision.

## **1.2 General safety instructions**

- Do not make changes to the parameters of this device.
- If the dryer is installed on top of a washing machine, use an installation kit. The vertical installation kit, available from authorized retailers, can only be used with appliances that are listed in the instructions supplied with the accessory.

Please review them carefully before installation (see Installation Instructions Insert).

- The device can be installed either separately or under the countertop, if there is enough space underneath (see insert with installation instructions).
- Do not install the appliance behind a locked door, a sliding door, or a door with hinges on the opposite side of the appliance door that would prevent the appliance door from opening completely.
- The ventilation hole in the bottom (if provided by the design) should not be blocked by carpet, rug, stand or any other floor covering.
- **ATTENTION:** The device must not be connected to the electrical network through external switching devices, such as timers, and also through circuits that are regularly are connected and disconnected by the electricity supplier.



- Insert the power cable plug into the socket only after completing the installation process of the device. Make sure that the power cord plug is accessible after installation.
- Ensure good ventilation in the area where the appliance is installed to prevent the backflow of unwanted gases into the room caused by appliances that burn gas or other fuels (including fireplaces).
- The air emitted by the appliance must not be vented into an exhaust system used for any appliance that burns gas or other fuels.
- If the power supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer to avoid electric shock.  
an authorized service center or a similarly qualified technician.
- Do not exceed the maximum permissible load of 8 kg (see Chapter "Program Table").
- Do not use the appliance on items that have been cleaned with industrial chemicals.
- Remove any lint that has accumulated around the appliance, as well as any packaging.
- Do not use the device without a filter. Clean the lint filter after or before each use.
- Do not tumble dry unwashed items.
- Before tumble drying items contaminated with substances such as cooking oil, acetone, alcohol, gasoline, kerosene, stain removers, turpentine, wax and wax removers, they should be washed in hot water with an increased amount of laundry detergent.



- Do not tumble dry foam rubber items (latex sponge), shower caps, waterproof textiles, rubber-based items, clothing or pillows with foam rubber inserts.
- Fabric softeners and other similar products should be used according to their manufacturer's directions.
- Remove any items that could cause a fire, such as lighters or matches.
- Never stop tumble dryers until the drying cycle has completed unless the laundry is quickly removed and spread out to allow heat dissipation.
- The final stage of the tumble drying cycle is performed without heat (cooling stage) to ensure that the final the temperature of the linen allowed to ensure its safety.
- Before performing any cleaning or maintenance operations, turn off the appliance and unplug the power cord from the outlet.

## 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

### 2.1 Installation

- Remove all packaging.
- Do not install or connect a damaged device.
- Follow the installation instructions included with the device.
- Never forget about safety precautions when using it. moving: the device is heavy. Always wear protective gloves and closed shoes.
- Do not install or operate the device in areas with temperatures below 5°C or above 35°C.
- The floor at the installation site of the device must be level, durable, clean and not afraid of heating.
- Make sure there is space between the bottom of the appliance and the floor. sufficient ventilation.
- The device must always be in an upright position when moving.
- The back of the appliance should be positioned against a wall.
- After installing the device in working position, use a spirit level to make sure that the device is absolutely level. Otherwise, adjust the height of the legs accordingly.



## 2.2 Connection to

### electrical networks

**ATTENTION!**

There is a risk of fire and electric shock.

- The device must be grounded.
- Ensure that the power supply specified on the rating plate is

correspond to the parameters of the electrical network. Otherwise, contact an electrician.

- Connect the device only to a properly installed electrical outlet with a protective contact.
- Do not use tees or extensions.
- To disconnect the device from the power supply, do not pull on the power cord. Always grip the fork itself.
- Do not handle the power cord or plug with wet hands.
- This device complies with EEC directives

## 2.3 Operation

**ATTENTION!**

- Do not dry damaged (torn, frayed) items with padding or inserts.
- Only dry fabrics that are suitable for tumble drying. Follow label directions.
- If a stain remover was used when washing laundry, then before placing the laundry in

tumble dryer, you should perform an additional rinse cycle.

- Do not drink condensation/distilled water or cook food with it. This may cause harm to the health of people and pets.
- Do not sit or stand on an open door.
- Do not tumble dry items that have not been wrung out.

## 2.4 Care and cleaning

**ATTENTION!**

This may result in damage to the device or injury.

- Do not use water supply to clean the device.
- Wipe the device with a soft, damp cloth. Use only neutral detergents. Do not use abrasives, scouring pads, solvents or metal objects.

## 2.5 Disposal

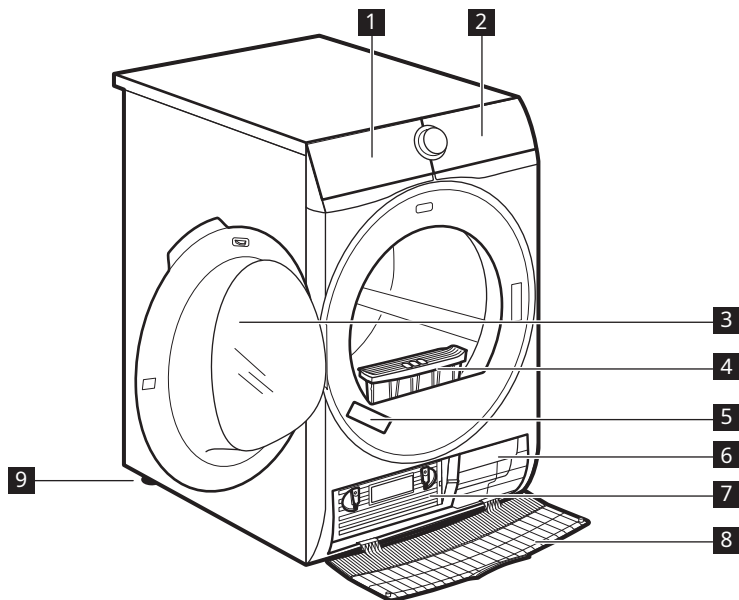

## 6. MODES

### 6.1 Add. drying degree



This option allows you to achieve the required degree of drying. Possible selections:

## 6.2 delicate fabrics

Extremely gentle drying at low temperatures for items that are frequently worn.

## 6.3 Gentle drying

Gentle drying of items subject to frequent wear. The heat is slowly reduced until the end of the cycle.

 Gentle drying and  delicate fabrics cannot be selected at the same time.

## 6.4 Anti-crease

Increasing the standard time of the “anti-crease” phase (30 minutes) at the end of the drying cycle to 120 minutes. At the end of the drying phase, the drum rotates from time to time to prevent wrinkles from forming on the clothes. During the Anti-Wrinkle phase, the laundry can be removed from the dryer.

## 6.5 Drying time

For cotton, synthetic or blended fabrics. Independent


User can set the drying time from 10 minutes to 2 hours (in steps of 10 minutes). When this option is enabled, the maximum download size indication disappears.



## 6.6 Start delay



Delay the start of the drying program from 30 minutes (minimum) up to 20 hours (maximum).

1. Select the drying program and options.

2. Touch the button  Delay start the required number of times. The display will show the value delays (for example, **12h** to start program after 12 hours).

3. To enable the option  Delay start, tap the Pause  Start/ button.

The display will begin counting down the time remaining until the start.

## 6.7 Sound signal

A sound signal is issued in the following cases:

- cycle completion
- beginning and end of the “anti-crease” stage

By default, the beep is always on. Using this option, you can enable or disable the sound signal.

# 7. BEFORE FIRST USE

Before using the device for the first time:

- Wipe the dryer drum with a damp cloth.

- Run a short program (eg 30 minutes) with damp laundry.

# 8. DAILY USE

## 8.1 Preparing laundry





- Close the zippers.

- Fasten the buttons or other fastenings of the duvet covers.
- Do not dry ties or ribbons (such as apron strings) in



- free form. Tie them before starting the program.
- Remove all contents from pockets.
  - If the garment has an inner layer of cotton wool, turn it inside out. The cotton layer should always be on the outside.
  - We recommend choosing a program that is suitable for the type of fabric from which the laundry is loaded into the appliance.
  - Do not load intensely colored items with light-colored fabrics.
  - For knits and cotton items, use the appropriate program to avoid shrinkage.

- Make sure that the load does not exceed the maximum capacity specified in the “Programs” Chapter or shown on the display.
- Only dry items that are suitable for tumble drying. Be guided by information on product labels.
- Do not dry large and small items together. Small items can become tangled in larger items and remain wet.

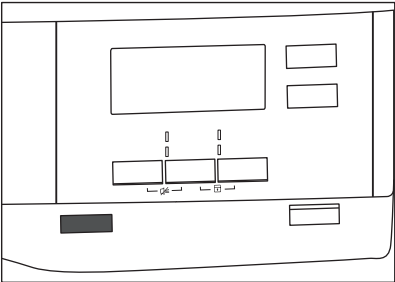
### 8.2 Loading laundry

### 8.3 Switching on the device



To turn on the device:

Click on the button  On off.  
If the device is turned on, a series of indicators will light up on the display.


### 8.4 Auto Off function

To reduce power consumption, the Auto Off function automatically



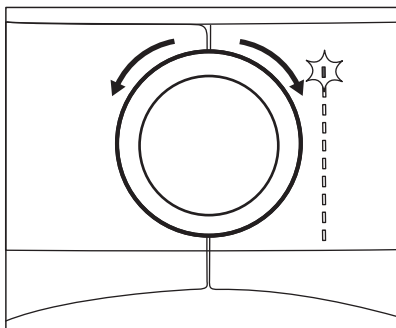
turns off the device in the following cases:

- if you haven't touched the touch Start/Pause buttons for five minutes;
- five minutes after the end of the program.


Click on the button  On/Off for turning on the device.

When the device is turned on, a number of indicators appear on the display.

## 8.5 Program selection

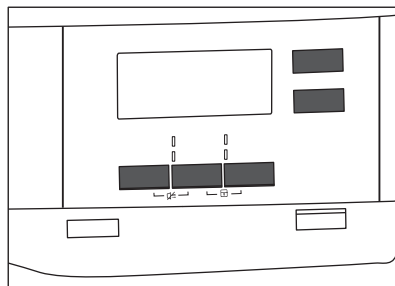


To select a program use the program selector. The display will show information about the approximate duration of the selected program.

-  Displayed on screen drying time calculated based on a load of 5 kg of cotton products. Information about other programs calculated based on the recommended loading volumes for them. On drying loads of cotton products exceeding 5 kg, more will be needed time.

When the option is enabled, the LED above the button lights up or a symbol appears on the display.

## 8.7 Option "Child lock"

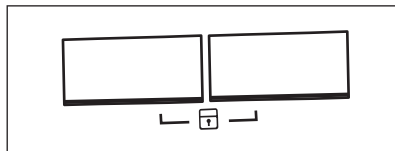
To prevent children from playing with the device, you can install a child lock. The Child Lock option locks all touch buttons and

program selector (button  On/Off not blocked).


The "Child Lock" option can be enabled:

- before touching the button  Start/Pause – the device will be impossible to start;
- after touching the button  Start/Pause – selection and launch of programs and options will not be available.

## Setting the "Child Lock" option:



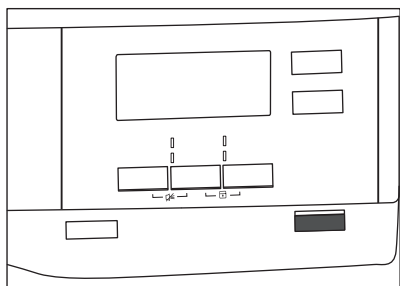
1. Turn on the dryer.
2. Select one of the available programs.
3. At the same time touch and hold down two buttons at the same time.

The symbol will appear on the display .



4. To turn off the "Protection" function "from children" touch the above buttons again so that this symbol disappears from the display.

## 8.8 Starting the program



To run the program:

Touch the button **▶|| Start/Pause**. The device will start working, and the LED above the button will stop blinking and light up continuously.

## 8.9 Program change

To change the program:

1. Click on the button **ⓘ On off** to turn off the device.
2. Click the button again **ⓘ On/Off** to turn on the device.
3. Set a new program.

## 8.10 End of the program



Do the cleaning filter and empty Condensate container after each cycle drying (See Chapter "CARE AND CLEANING").

At the end of the drying cycle, the symbol flashes on the display. If The Sound Alarm option is turned on, for one minute there will be an intermittent beep will sound.



If the device is not turn it off, it will start anti-crease stage (not applicable to all programs). Flashing symbol indicates execution of the stage anti-crease. During After completing this step, the laundry can be removed from the appliance.

Removing laundry:

1. To turn off the device, press for 2 seconds on the **On/Off** button.
2. Open the appliance door.
3. Take out the laundry.
4. Close the appliance door.

## 9.1 Recommendations for

- before drying the osho squeeze it out laundry.
- Do not exceed those rm loading, specified in Table ice programs.

- Clean the filter after each drying cycle.
- Do not use fabric softener during washing if the laundry is to be dried. Tumble dried laundry automatically becomes soft.



- Use distilled water for steam ironing. If necessary, first filter the distilled water (e.g.

coffee filter) to remove various particles from it.

- Always ensure that the ventilation slots in the base of the appliance are not blocked.
- Ensure good ventilation where the device is installed.

## 9.2 Adjusting the default degree drying

To change the default drying level:

1. Turn on the device.
2. Select one of the available programs.
3. At the same time touch and hold the buttons **Anti-crease** and **Time**.

One of the symbols will appear on the display:

**CO** – Maximum degree drying

**CO=** – Increased degree of drying

**COE** – Standard degree of drying

4. To select the desired level, touch the button **Start/Pause** until the desired degree of dryness is achieved.

## 9.3 Turning off the water container indicator

*By default, the condensate container indication is switched on. If the container is full, it always turns on at the end of the drying cycle or during the drying cycle. If a condensate drain kit is installed, emptying the container*

Turn off the indication:

1. Turn on the device.
2. Select one of the available programs.

## 10. CARE AND CLEANING

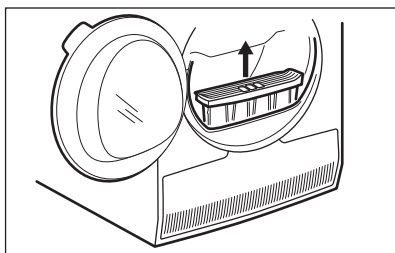
### 10.1 Cleaning the filter

At the end of each cycle on the display symbol appears  *Clean the filters*; this means that the filter needs to be cleaned.

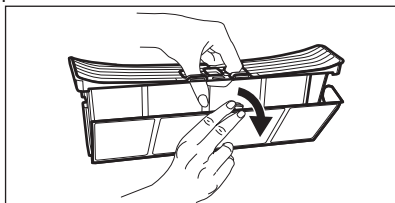
 The filter collects lint, accumulating during drying cycle.

Cleaning the filter:

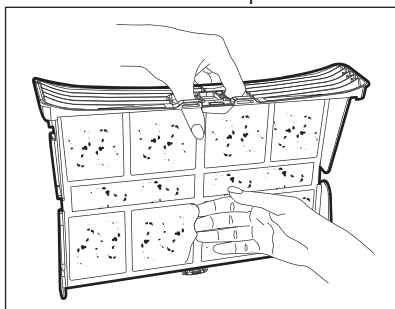
1. Open the door. Pull filter up.



2. Open the filter.



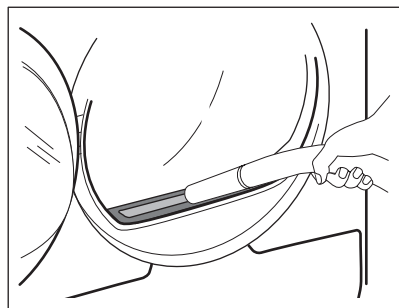
3. Clean the filter with a damp hand.



4. If necessary, you clean it with a vacuum cleaner filter. m. Close the filter.

5. If necessary, remove the lint from the filter slot and the s...

seal. You can use a vacuum cleaner for this. Place the filter back into the filter slot.



### 10.2 Draining water from the collection container condensate

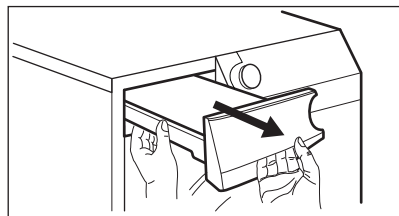
Empty the condensation container after each drying cycle.

If the condensate container is full, the program stops automatically. On

the symbol appears on the display *Drain the condensate*; this means that the condensate container must be emptied.

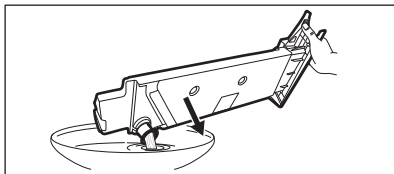
To drain the water:

1. Remove the collection container condensation, keeping it horizontal.



2. Pull out the plastic connector and drain the contents of the condensate container into a basin or suitable container.





3. Slide the plastic connector back and replace the condensate container.

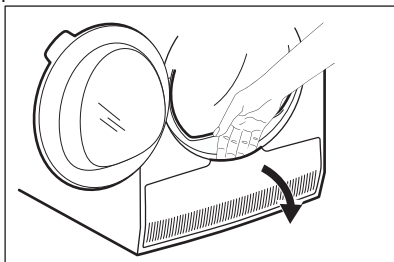

### 10.3 Cleaning the condenser

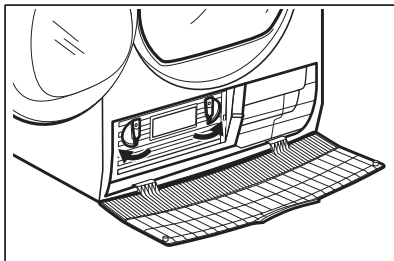

5. Feel for the handle and pull it out capacitor from the basement compartment. When moving, hold the capacitor horizontally so as not to spill the remaining water.



6. Clean the condenser by turning it upside down place it in a vertical position over a sink or basin. Rinse it with a shower head.



7. Place the capacitor back into basement compartment.
8. Close the condenser cover.
9. Close the two locking levers before they are fixed.
10. Close the condenser cover.



10.4 Cleaning the drum



**ATTENTION!**

Before cleaning, disconnect the device from the power supply.

Use a neutral detergent to clean the inside of the drum and its fins. Wipe the washed surfaces with a soft cloth.



**WARNING**

Do not use abrasive products to clean the drum, materials or metal jaws.

10.5 Cleaning the panel control and housing

Use a neutral detergent to clean the control panel and cabinet.

Use a damp cloth to clean. Wipe washed surface with a soft cloth.



**WARNING**

Do not use detergents to clean the device. furniture washing and cleaning agents that may cause corrosion.


